







Type of Book	Purpose	Bookmark
<b>Guided Reading books</b>	To help guide children through books that are just above the child's independent reading level.	 <p>1 - This is a book to share. It is just a little too hard for me.</p>
<b>Familiar books</b>	To help children to develop fluency, expression and extend vocabulary. Research has shown that repeated exposure to a book helps build and cement vocabulary acquisition.	 <p>2 - This is an easy book. I am practising fluency and expression!</p>
<b>Get Reading Right Practice Books</b>	A great precursor to a decodable story. Reinforce knowledge of phonemes, blending and segmenting.	 <p>3 - This book helps me learn my phonemes. I can sound out all the words.</p>
<b>Library books and books of interest from the class library</b>	To develop children's interest in books. Children should be read to often so that they learn about stories and life beyond their experiences.	 <p>4 - Read this book to me. I cannot read it on my own. Thanks!</p>
<b>Get Reading Right Decodable Stories</b>	To support and encourage children to read.	 <p>5 - I can read this book on my own.</p>
<b>Get Reading Right camera books</b>	To reinforce reading and spelling of irregular, high frequency words.	 <p>6 - This book helps me learn my camera words.</p>
